## Standards of Care - Guinea Pigs

- 1) Food (Standard Irradiated), water, bedding (Aspen shavings & corn cob), enrichment (Timothy Hay, tunnels, fresh produce)
- 2) Cage change twice per week
- 3) Cage Wash (Caging and Chemical Supplies)
- 4) Floors swept daily
  - a) Floors mopped weekly and waxed when needed
- 5) Walls, ceiling, vents, horizontal surfaces sanitized monthly
- 6) Daily Health Checks (Everyday including holiday and weekends)
- 7) Veterinary Oversight
- 8) Compliance Oversight
- 9) Equipment maintenance -, environmental monitoring devices, tunnel washer, rack washer, autoclaves and euthanasia stations, Edstrom watering system (LKS)

   a. i, chemicals for cage wash, gaskets for autoclaves and CO2 tanks where needed, and all preventative maintenance
- 10) Replacement of worn cages
- 11) Certification of OLAC Anesthesia machines annually
- 12) Quality Assurance/Control

a. ATP testing quarterly

- 13) Maintain a stocked pharmacy
- 14) Purchasing, receiving, and transfers of animals
  - a) Additional fee for transfers to a different building
- 15) PPE
- 16) Clean cage stock kept in the area and available.
- 17) Standard cage cards
- 18) Census Scanning
- 19) Printing stickers for cage cards and special services
- 20)Cayuse Software program, providing billing, recharge assistance and health case tracking
- 21) Facility Services liaison
- 22) Maintenance of vivarium WiFi and security
- 23) Key Card reader purchase and maintenance
- 24) Purchasing animal care supplies including feed, bedding and standard enrichment
- 25) Telephones
