- Re: Shepherd Shacks

The Standard Enrichment for mice has been instituted. There have been requests for Shepherd Shacks. This memo is intended to inform everyone how this will be handled.

- 1. Shepherd Shacks will be purchased by OLAC and made available for purchase to Investigators.
- 2. OLAC will bag Shepherd Shacks in sleeves of 10.
- 3. PI will request Shacks through the OLAC website:
 - a. Special Services Request
 - b. Non-Animal Order
- 4. Shacks will be picked up by the PI or PI staff at the OLAC office in NAF 203
- 5. A sleeve of shacks will be approximately \$6.00.
- 6. In the Facility:
 - a. PI/PI Staff will apply spray disinfectant to the outside of the sleeve before entering the housing facility.
 - b. Sleeves must be housed in a closed Tupperware-type box with a label indicating the PI's name
 - c. OLAC will not be responsible for these shacks.
 - d. PI will be responsible for placing the shacks in the cages and replacing them when they become soiled or destroyed by chewing.
 - e. OLAC staff will only transfer shacks; they will not be responsible for their placement.

- f. PI is responsible for amending their AUP if the standard enrichment is to be replaced by the Shack. Otherwise, the standard enrichment MUST be placed and used.
- g. Failure to amend the protocol coupled with the removal of the standard enrichment would be considered out of compliance with ACUC Environmental Enrichment Guidelines, and reportable to the ACUC.
