


PURPOSE

The purpose of this SOP is to define how veterinary oversight of nonhuman primates will be routinely documented.

SCOPE

This SOP covers the procedures to be followed during monthly clinical evaluation of nonhuman primates and lab compliance by veterinary staff.

RESPONSIBILITY

These oversight duties are the responsibility of the veterinary staff. Primary responsibility belongs to the animal health technician(s) assigned to rounding nonhuman primate areas. Laboratory staff is responsible for keeping any weight and water logs described in the animal use protocol.

DEFINITIONS/ACRONYMS

- OLAC: Office of Laboratory Animal Care
- AHT: Animal Health Technician
- NHP: Nonhuman Primate

PROCEDURE

- Monthly:
 - Clinical evaluation of each nonhuman primate
 - Perform cageside visual exam
 - Record the following in clinical record: attitude; mobility; hydration status; fecal/urine output; any abnormal clinical findings
 - Review baseline weight information, laboratory weight and water logs

- c. Report any issues to a veterinarian
