PROCEDURE

All work instructions must be demonstrated by the trainer and performed by the trainee.

1. Safety Considerations:

a. Walk around the perimeter of the enclosure to prevent accidental damage of underground burrows.

2. Health:

- a. Observe animals while foraging at the surface and during nest box bedding change, this provides additional confirmation the animals are active and in good condition.
- b. If animals are underground and unable to be visualized for health check, confirm that the previous day's produce has been eaten.

3. Nest box:

- a. Remove the cover/lid located on top of each nest box.
- b. Open the nest box and remove the bedding.
 - Discard the soiled bedding in the trash.
- c. Check the box for condensation.
 - If condensation is present, dry the box by wiping it with a cloth or paper towel.
- d. Place new nesting material (Aspen shavings and Envirodry) into the nest box.
- e. Close each nest box and place the cover/lid back on top.

4. Feed:

a. Place ¼ cup of rodent food into each nest box.

- b. Place three (3) baby carrots & one (1) leaf of romaine lettuce per animal.
 - The number of animal(s) per pen are noted on the sides of the enclosure.
 - Produce is stored in the feed storage room refrigerator in building.
